


ABOUT US

We offer a selection of effective tools for prevention education. New tools are frequently being added.

Fatal Vision® Impairment Goggles



This is the popular, evidence-based prevention tool used to educate all ages about the consequences of alcohol misuse and abuse.

Fatal Vision® Goggles

use special lens technology that allows the wearer to experience a realistic simulation of impairment. Participants experience how alcohol impairs a person's balance, vision, reaction time, and judgment.



SIDNE® Impaired Driving Simulator



Simulated Impaired Driving Experience®, or **SIDNE®**, is a battery-powered vehicle that simulates the effects of distraction and impairment from alcohol and other drugs on a motorist's driving skills.

Presented on a driving course, SIDNE® is controlled by a radar gun that can make the vehicle respond as if the driver was impaired. It allows the driver and passenger to experience driving impaired in a controlled environment.



Mobile Crash Car Trailer



Our **Mobile Educational Crash Car Trailer** contains a vehicle that was involved in a fatal DUI crash. It allows individuals to see close up the results of one bad decision, but the trailer serves as an important resource for parents to start conversations with their children about the consequences of poor choices.

This simple matching game helps demonstrate in a fun and engaging way, the impact of distractions on reaction time and judgment, helping extend the lesson on the impact of distracted driving.
